Take notice of posted warning signs and keep clear of electrical equipment.



Do not shoot at or near power lines or insulators.



Know where power lines and equipment are



Be especially careful in wooded areas where power lines may not be as visible.



Do not place deer stands on utility poles or climb poles. Energized lines and equipment can conduct electricity to anyone who comes in contact with them, causing shock or electrocution.



Do not place decoys on power lines or other utility equipment. Any non-electrical equipment attached to a pole can pose an obstruction and serious hazards to our line crews

Water heating accounts for a large portion of home energy bills. To save energy (and money!) used for water heating, repair any leaky faucets. install low-flow fixtures and insulate accessible hot water lines.

Beef lumpia, pork bihon, and pork tocino with steamed rice.

Aileen's Beef Lumpia

Ingredients:



| 1 tablespoon vegetable oil | 1 tsp black pepper |
|---------------------------------|--|
| 1 pound of ground beef | 1 tsp salt |
| ½ c chopped onions | 1 tsp garlic powder |
| 2 cloves garlic, crushed | 1 tsp soy sauce |
| ½ c minced carrots | 30 lumpia wrappers |
| ½ c chopped green onions | 2 c vegetable oil for frying, or as needed |
| ½ c thinly sliced green cabbage | |

Directions:

- Heat 1 tablespoon vegetable oil in a large skillet over high heat. Add beef; cook and stir for 5 to 7 minutes.
- Add onion and garlic to pan, cook and stir for about 2 minutes. Stir in the cooked beef, carrots, green onions, and cabbage. Season with pepper, salt, garlic powder and soy sauce. Remove from heat and set aside until cool enough to handle.
- Assemble lumpia: place 3 heaping tablespoons of filling diagonally near one corner of the lumpia wrapper. Fold the
- side along the length of the filling over the filling tuck in both ends and roll neatly and tightly to close. Moisten the other side of the wrapper with water to seat the edge.
- 4. Heat vegetable oil in a heavy skillet over medium heat for 5 minutes. Place the lumpia in the hot oil, making sure seams are facing down. Fry, turning occasionally until all sides are golden brown, 1 to 2 minutes. Transfer to a paper towel-lined plate to drain. Serve immediately.
